## RESOLUTION 25-XXX

### RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR ROAD REPAIRS FOR THE SUNSET, PANORAMA, AND CRESTLINE NEIGHBORHOOD

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2022, City Council received the 1st Quarter Financial Report for Fiscal Year 2022-23, including the financial status of Measure J-20 (hereinafter referred to as J-20), the City's one cent supplemental sales tax approved by voters in 2020; and

WHEREAS, City Council directed staff to develop a list of streets and roads to use J-20 reserve funds towards for additional street maintenance; and

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2025 City Council authorized the use of unappropriated Measure J-20 funds to repair and resurface the streets within the Sunset, Panorama, and Crestline neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared and advertised for bid with an engineer's estimate of \$2,100,000 as part of a formal Request for Proposal process consistent with City's Purchasing Policy and on August 21, 2025, five (5) bids were received ranging from \$1,619,999.00 to \$1,835,116.20; and

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed the lowest bid from Westrock Construction and found it to be a responsive and responsible bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All the above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Award a construction contract to Westrock General Engineering to perform road repairs within the Sunset, Panorama, and Crestline Neighborhood, in the amount of \$1,619,999, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement, subject to any minor, technical, or non-substantive changes as approved by the City Manager and the City Attorney.

Section 3. The City finds that this action is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") under the Class 1 exemption, which applies to the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features where the project involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use (State CEQA Guidelines, § 15301).
