Hi Darren & Piper-

I've attached an amended application as I have been told that getting an emergency permit is pretty much impossible and I really need to get some movement on this.

I've also attached the arborist report as well as some photos that more accurately portray why I am so concerned. They show how much the tree is leaning and, because of the lopsided arrangements of the major limbs, how it will be impossible to merely trim the tree to lessen the weight.

I don't hate oak trees! But this one probably should have been removed in 1918 when the home was built. I've lived in Paso Robles my entire life and have seen numerous occasions the damage that a falling oak tree can cause. One fallen limb several years ago cost me \$7500.00 to deal with. I cannot imagine what the cost would be if the entire tree goes over. And, my insurance did not cover the damage the last time. So I'm pretty sure, given the state of insurance companies now, it will not cover it this time.
