RESOLUTION 25-XXX

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY AMBULANCE SERVICES REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH AP TRITON FOR ASSOCIATED CONSULTING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the seven incorporated cities of San Luis Obispo County are collaborating to develop a unified, coordinated, and accountable emergency medical services (EMS) system to enhance efficiency, transparency, and long-term sustainability; and

WHEREAS, the proposed “Alliance Model” is a public-private partnership designating the City of Paso Robles as the provider of record, with oversight provided by an executive committee composed of the seven city managers; and

WHEREAS, the Alliance Model provides access to federal funding streams that are only available to public entities. These funds can be reinvested directly into EMS system improvements; and

WHEREAS, the benefits of the Alliance Model include improved transparency, reinvestment of revenues into system enhancements, preventative health programs, and services for vulnerable populations, including those experiencing mental health crises and homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Luis Obispo will be releasing a competitive RFP for ambulance transport services, and participation by the City of Paso Robles will advance regional EMS collaboration, innovation, and accountability; and

WHEREAS, given the technical complexity of ambulance service procurement, the City requires the expertise of AP Triton to assist with preparing a competitive and compliant proposal; and

WHEREAS, AP Triton, based on past work for the City associated with this larger matter, is privy to sensitive City information that includes system evaluations and financial projections, and going out to competitive bid would prejudice the City and the sensitivity of that information; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approves sole source findings under Section 5.0 of City’s Purchasing and Payment Procedures Manual, in awarding the consulting services to AP Triton contemplated by this item; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of AP Triton’s consulting services is \$255,749, of which the City of Paso Robles’ share estimated cost is \$50,753.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All of the above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes participation in the San Luis Obispo County Ambulance Services RFP.

Section 3. The City Council approves and authorizes the City Manager to execute a professional services agreement with AP Triton in the amount of \$255,749, with the City’s share being

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estimated at \$50,753 for consulting services necessary to prepare and submit a competitive proposal.

Section 4. The City find that this action is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State Guidelines Section State CEQA Guidelines, §§ 15060, subd. (c)(2)-(3), 15378 because the contemplated actions will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.
