Hello!

I am a realtor, based in Paso Robles. I am being informed that only two Open House signs will be allowed under the new ordinance. I frequently list homes on Fieldstone Circle. That street is tucked away off Larkfield Place. In order to ensure traffic to the Open House, I need to put signs as far away as Creston and Meadowlark. I then place other signs in between to direct traffic appropriately. If I were only allowed one sign at Creston and Meadowlark and one sign at Fieldstone and Larkfield, potential attendees would not be able to figure out which home is open and would likely give up in frustration. Signs are generally put up for a maximum of four hours and taken down when the Open House has ended. I've never had a neighbor complain about the signs, and I've never had a sign removed. I hope you will reconsider your intention to permit only two signs.
