RESOLUTION 26-XXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY REGIONAL HOMELESSNESS AND AFFORDABLE HOUSING COMPACT

WHEREAS, homelessness in San Luis Obispo County is a complex, countywide challenge requiring unified, compassionate, and strategic action; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Luis Obispo and the seven incorporated cities recognize that addressing homelessness effectively requires shared responsibility, coordinated planning, and alignment of local and regional strategies; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Luis Obispo and the seven incorporated cities have collaborated to develop the San Luis Obispo County Regional Homelessness and Affordable Housing Compact ("Compact") which establishes a non-binding, collaborative framework through which participating jurisdictions commit to shared principles to guide individual and collective actions, including treating all people with dignity, strengthening regional collaboration, expanding housing and services, sharing responsibility and resources, promoting transparency and accountability, and fostering community wellbeing and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Compact aligns with the regional collaboration priorities outlined in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-26 Paso Robles City Council Adopted Goals and the FY 2024- 27 Paso Robles Strategic Plan to Address Homelessness; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Compact is intended to strengthen regional partnerships, improve coordination across jurisdictions, and enhance competitiveness for state and federal funding opportunities to address homelessness and affordable housing needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All of the above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The City Council hereby supports the San Luis Obispo County Regional Homelessness and Affordable Housing Compact, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to sign the Compact at a future date in collaboration and coordination with the County and the other six incorporated cities.

Section 4. The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or their designee, to coordinate City actions and collaborate with the County, cities, and regional partners to align planning, data sharing and implementation efforts consistent with the Compact, subject to applicable City policies, regulatory restrictions, and budgetary authority.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect on the date it is approved by City Council.
