Dear Mayor Hamon and Council Members:

After serious consideration, I am pleased to submit my application to serve as the Council Member for District 1.

I want to acknowledge Mayor Martin's leadership and the Council's hard work in identifying meaningful goals for the City: economic vitality, infrastructure, housing, public safety, quality of life, and governance. The adopted goals, informed by public participation, are an excellent roadmap to strengthen our community resources that serve all our residents. In addition, I appreciate how the council works together to address the challenges facing our community. I believe my unique skills and experience will complement the existing efforts to realize the City's goals and vision.

I came to Paso Robles as a young girl in the 70's. I was a 4-H'er, Pioneer Player, and PRHS graduate. Later, I was a single mom, a baseball mom, and a Bearcat mom. I chose to raise my son here on purpose. Paso is my home and I care deeply about creating economic and quality of life opportunities for our community.

I earned my Masters in Agriculture at Cal Poly. In my early career, I taught irrigation at Cal Poly, conducted research at the Irrigation Training and Research Center, educated first responders through the County Ag Department, analyzed ag water use numbers for the county master water plan in the 90's, and co-authored a textbook.

Later, I served as Executive Director to the Vineyard Team, a local non-profit dedicated to sustainable winegrowing – a position I held for 23 years. We conducted research and education on integrated pest management, irrigation management, water quality, and more. We conducted grower-to-grower and worker-to-worker outreach in English and Spanish. We initiated a scholarship program for children of agricultural workers, and have distributed \$270K since 2015.

Our work was rooted in education, outreach, cooperative partnerships, relationship building, and reliable information. We were recognized as leaders by the Environmental Protection Agency, Regional Water Quality Control Board, Department of Water Resources, and Department of Pesticide Regulation. Personally, I was honored with the SLO County Winegrower Person of the Year Award and California Ag Leadership Profile in Leadership Award. In both cases, I was selected by my peers.

I worked with small and large farmers, environmentalists, non-profits, and regulators. I've led and sat on committees. Locally, I sat on various water committees. I've spent considerable time collaborating with government agencies.

After much reflection, I see the roles and responsibilities of a council member as being very similar to that of an executive director.

From a business perspective, I managed budgets, payroll, communications, services, contracts, compliance, and programs. I was an employee and an employer. While a non-profit is "owned" by the public, the business practices still apply.

In addition, a council member is a public facing ambassador for the city, who both shares and receives information from the community. These communications must be two way and based on respect to build understanding. In addition, the council, with input from the community, leads a goal setting process that serves as a road map for staff. The council conducts oversight to ensure progress towards measurable objectives. These responsibilities are key for effective operations and developing public trust. As Executive Director, I fulfilled these roles.

The skills and experience I bring complement the strengths of the current council. I am semi-retired and have the time to commit to the work. I do not have conflicts with council business. I am ready to serve our community in a new way.

While we all wish this appointment weren't necessary, this is an opportunity for us to honor Mayor Martin's legacy by ensuring the city's goals are realized and that we lead with care for our entire community. We can do this by continuing to steward productive and respectful relationships, strengthening collaborative partnerships, building on the assets of the council, and approaching this chapter with hard work and enthusiasm.
