Council then disclosed that in addition to the names read, there were other letters of support they had received by email. Council then began their deliberation and narrowed the candidates to four, Sharon Roden, Sarah Hinds-Martin, Elizabeth Lee, and Linda George and asked those candidates to participate in an additional interview session. At the conclusion of the additional interview session, Council reached a consensus and directed staff to return to the October 3, 2023 City Council meeting with an item to appoint Sharon Roden to the District 1 Council Seat and to administer the oath of office upon approval of that appointment.
