NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Paso Robles City Council will hold a Public Hearing to consider the following project:

Project Description: A request to amend No. 16 of City Council Resolution 21-0145 that requires a road maintenance agreement for the ABI project. The ABI project would develop the site with a new 6,200 square foot industrial building for ABI Construction that would include a maintenance shop, office, and accessory outdoor storage of equipment and materials, on the 2-acre site.

CEQA Determination: This application is Categorically Exempt from environmental review per Section 15332 (Infill) of the State's Guidelines to Implement the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

Hearing Date: The City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, March 7, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. at the City of Paso Robles, 1000 Spring Street, Paso Robles, California, in the City Council Chamber.

The Planning Commission held a public hearing for the project on February 14, 2023, and on a vote of 4-3 recommended the City Council amend Condition #16 to allow the project to proceed without a road maintenance agreement.

The City of Paso Robles is holding hybrid City Council meetings. The public now has the option to attend the meeting in person or to participate remotely, pursuant to AB 361, which allows for a deviation of the Ralph M. Brown Act's standard teleconference requirements. The meeting will be a hybrid meeting because there exists a Governor proclaimed state of emergency and state and local officials are recommending measures to promote social distancing. City Council meetings will be held in this manner until further notice.

The phone line will open just prior to the start of the meeting. Further directions on providing live telephone comments will be included in the Council agenda and during the public hearing. Written public comments can be submitted via email to cityclerk@prcity.com or US Mail (submit early) to the City Clerk, 1000 Spring Street, Paso Robles, CA 93446 provided that the comments are received prior to the time of the public hearing. Comments received prior to 12:00 noon on the day of the meeting will be posted as an addendum to the agenda. If submitting written comments, please note the agenda item by number or name. Challenge to the application in court, will be limited to issues raised at the

public hearings or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or

prior to, the public hearing.


