Subject: Receipt of the Annual Fire Inspection Report for State Mandated Occupancies

CEQA Determination: The City finds that this action is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State Guidelines Section State CEQA Guidelines, §§ 15060, subd. (c)(2)-(3), 15378.

Date: July 16, 2024

Facts

1. California Health & Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 requires all fire departments, including Paso Robles Fire and Emergency Services (PRFES), to perform annual inspections in every building used as a public or private school, hotel, motel, lodging house, apartment house, jails, and certain residential care facilities for compliance with building and fire standards.
2. Senate Bill 1205 added Section 13146.4 to the Health and Safety Code requiring every organized fire department to annually report their compliance with State mandated inspections.
3. For Fiscal Year 2023-24, PRFES completed 19 of 19 (100%) of the City's group E educational facilities; completed 123 of 123 (100%) residential group R occupancies (hotel, motel, apartment, and tri-plex); and completed 1 of 1 (100 %) institutional group I occupancies (city jail).

Options

1. Take no action.
2. Approve Resolution 24-XXX, receiving and filing the Annual Fire Inspection Report for State Mandated Occupancies.

Analysis and Conclusions

Accepting and filing the attached Resolution meets the requirements of California Health & Safety Code 13146.4 and acknowledges Paso Robles Fire and Emergency Services compliance with California Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3. This resolution and related report confirms the annual inspections only and does not contain findings.
