RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

ACCEPTING DEDICATING A GRANT OF EASEMENT FOR ELECTICAL LINE USE, INCLUDING THE RIGHT
TO CONSTRUCT, RECONSTRUCT, REPAIR, AND MAINTAIN FOR PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC AND
FIND THE ACTION EXEMPT FROM CEQA

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company has existing electrical service facilities across a portion of City owned land; and

WHEREAS, the portion of land that the poles and wires cross require a fifty-foot wide easement for improvements, access, and maintenance on City land; and

WHEREAS, a portion of land owned by the City has existing City owned and maintained facilities that cross under the existing Pacific Gas and Electric Company facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide fordedicate a Grant of Easement for Pacific Gas and Electric Company for the electrical line facility area on City property; and

WHEREAS, the Grant of Easement for electrical line use for PG&E is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") under the Class 2 exemption, which applies to the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced. (State CEQA Guidelines, § 15302.)

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All of the above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The City Council accepts dedicates the Grant of Easement for electrical line use for Pacific Gas and Electric Company, and authorizes the City Manager or designee to sign and record the Grant of Easement attached hereunto as Exhibit A.
