Community Services Director Angelica Fortin reported that she would be presenting an update on Youth Sports Field Capacity to City Council during their meeting on May 20, and that the trail repairs at Veterans Park have been completed.

Committeemember Newman reported on the Conceptual Design Review meeting for Larry Moore Park. Committeemember Clayton talked about how field capacity could be improved with the installation of artificial turf and suggested new field planning should include the consideration of artificial turf. Committeemember Zannotti complimented the city on the Larry Moore Park design review meeting and recent community events.

Councilmember Kris Beal shared that a couple of Paso Robles Joint United School District Trustees have mentioned that youth sports are competing for limited outdoor spaces. Councilmember Beal invited interested parties to the May 20 City Council meeting to hear the Community Services Director's presentation on Youth Sports Field Capacity and to give public comment. She also reported that parents and their children were very happy about the spring break science camps at Centennial Park and encourages Recreation Services to plan all-day activities rather than half-day activities for children to help working parents.
